





84th Meeting Minutes

Started 19.55 12 August 2021 Ended 20.30 12 August 2021

## 1. Welcome and Introduction

Dave welcomed the members to the meeting. Minutes of the previous meeting were pointed out, and Dave mentioned that the minutes are now on the Wessex Blues website.
