





# Wessex Blues

93<sup>rd</sup> Meeting Minutes

Started 9<sup>th</sup> May 2022 19:20 Closed 9<sup>th</sup> May 2022 19:55

Location: Barking Cat, Ashley Road, Parkstone

#### 1. Welcome and Introduction

Richard thanked and welcomed members for coming to the meeting (12 members were present) as Robbie had not turned up for the start of the meeting. Richard confirmed he was not aware why Robbie was late or if he was going to turn up. Andy P stated that it looks like a record low attendance, end of season blues etc. possibly down to the Champions League defeat the previous week. Andy and Michael mentioned that game against Real Madrid was entertaining with great goals, just spoilt by the last few moments. At this point, Robbie turned up. Andy P and Michael mentioned that the atmosphere at the Leeds game was great and felt very old school. Robbie confirmed he was late due to being turned around by the police by turning down a no right turn....thankfully no caution. Michael asked Andy P how was getting into and leaving the ground in Madrid like? Andy confirmed that there were ten levels of stewards with no way of jumping the turnstiles. Andy mentioned that names were checked to see that no Tippex had been used to cover up any names by shining their torches. Andy P confirmed he saw no trouble and had to wait 45 minutes before leaving the stadium. ## 5. Any Other Business (AOB)

Richard handed out Wolves and West Ham tickets. Richard confirmed that the Wolves ticket arrived on Friday and West Ham this morning. Gavin asked Richard to let him know if any spare West Ham tickets became available. Joe turned up at this point. Joe confirmed he was late due to playing football. Paul confirmed that the refurbishment has been delayed and would start on the 15<sup>th</sup> June and hopefully finish on the 15<sup>th</sup> July, so the next meeting may again be the Barking Cat or at The Cricketers. Andy P asked if any of the branch rules would be changed at all for the forthcoming season. Andy P commented that it seemed to have gone well without any 'bust ups'. Richard confirmed that nothing was planned. Paul asked when committee roles were due. Richard confirmed that the General Secretary role was in September, while role of Chairperson was not until next year. It was agreed that all committee roles would take place in September including old and new roles that have not been used to date. Andy P asked about do we think we will scrape 20 members this coming season....Richard confirmed it was a worry and asked all members to do their best to get numbers to the 20 mark....Dave commented that this may be closer than you think as he and Annie are considering leaving the supporters club as he felt he was not getting any benefit from being a member. Joe confirmed that he sees a guy in the George Tapps wearing the full City Kit and wonders why he has not become a member. Joe confirmed he would approach this supporter on the next occasion. Robbie also mentioned he feels the same as he sees a lot of Manchester City supporters going to Southampton from Bournemouth for the game. Andy P asked with respect to the game at Bournemouth, would anybody be able to get a ticket for the game. Paul mentioned he should be able to get two tickets in the Bournemouth end. Andy P hoped it would be in the winter or a mid-week game to give us a better chance of getting a ticket. Richard confirmed that every year an email would go out to previous members to re-join. Robbie confirmed that East Sussex had acquired previous Weymouth members and had mini-buses to go to the game. Dave confirmed this. Richard confirmed that we are as a supporters' club one of the smallest in the country. Richard asked members do the best to acquire extra member in the summer months and at worst we would make family members official members to get us over the line. Joe asked if anybody was going to Wembley on Sunday to watch the women, while Paul asked if any one was going to the Villa game. Richard remained members that the supporters club was 10 years old in September and that Paul would organise some food via the Cricketers. Richard confirmed to Marilyn that based on an email of yesterday that they had a 50/50 chance of getting their Villa tickets. Joe confirmed that he may have two season ticket holders' tickets for Villa as they are unable to go. Paul also confirmed the same.
