109th Meeting Minutes

1. Welcome and Introduction

Robbie thanked and welcomed old and new members to our new venue for our meeting (18 members were present).

Michael and Dave approved the previous minutes from October.

3. General Secretary Update

Richard's father (Norman), previous member of the Wessex Blues was present and it was his birthday today, aged 91. Richard mentioned to members that he had brought in cake and food to share with members.

4. Treasurer Update

Current Bank balance and recent transactions - £1,225.08 (as of 9^{th} November). Richard confirmed that this was likely to fall to around ~£800-900 after payments had been made for Manchester City gifts and alcohol for the Christmas raffle and for food for the Christmas meal shortly.

5. Any Other Business (AOB)

Dave confirmed that the new chief could do mild chilli, spicy chilli, rice chips and French bread and would cost £10 per head which included wages and food, but Dave would need numbers confirmed to attend so to purchase the relevant and amount of food and would be likely be on a serve yourself basis. Andy H mentioned the local Chinese takeaway (Golden Horse) on Victoria Road as an alternative as Andy H mentioned they do a wonderful special fried rice. Andy H mentioned that they could do any meat dish with rice and/or noodles for £7 per head with also a vegetarian option which could be ordered 1 hour before. Richard confirmed that the club would pick up the entire cost of the food. Dave confirmed the majority of the cost would be for the chief's wages and food with a small fraction going back to the Royal Legion. Robbie asked would bringing food in from the Chinese be a problem for the Royal Legion. Dave confirmed that this would not be a problem as this has been done in previous times. Richard confirmed an email would go out at the end of November/early December for numbers who would attend the Christmas meal. To test the water, an unofficial vote was made and based on the majority of people present they would rather have a chilli etc.

Michael gave his apology and season greetings as he would not be attending the next meeting as he would be in New Zealand for the next 6 weeks on holiday. Andy P asked if he is exempt for the next meeting as he is in Belgrade for the away game against Manchester City. Richard confirmed that this was correct.
